

FROM UNCERTAINTY TO EMPOWERMENT: MARY'S STORY OF CARE AND COMPASSION

Mary has been a patient at Temple Community Clinic (TCC) and resided in the Temple area for over 20 years. She shared that when she first came to the clinic, she had no insurance and struggled to afford her medications and routine healthcare. While searching online for help with her children's immunizations, she found TCC.

Before discovering the clinic, Mary stated that she often felt "stressed and overwhelmed". She also stated that not having insurance affected her pride and left her feeling vulnerable and unsure of where to turn. At TCC, Mary received diabetes education, consistent primary care, and compassionate emotional support. She expressed that "they treat you with dignity, and they do not judge you." With the help of TCC's social work team, Mary was connected to resources that covered her Medicare premiums and provided access to affordable medications. The team also walked alongside her as she prepared to transition her care beyond TCC.

Now employed and more stable, Mary says the clinic helped her build independence and confidence in managing her health. Today, Mary describes feeling a renewed sense of hope and trust in healthcare. She believes that without TCC, she would still feel lost, stressed, and uncertain about her future, but instead she is moving forward with confidence.
